What is a Corio House?

Hope Uniting Church (located in Maroubra), in seeking to support students at UNSW and elsewhere, built two houses for student accommodation (each housing 4 students). Corio A and B are next to each other, and on the same block as Hope Uniting Church. Residents have their own furnished bedroom (bed, desk, chair, wardrobe, bedside table, and chest of drawers), shared bathroom, kitchen, laundry and living room.

Corio is an intentional Christian community supporting each other in friendship and faith. Residents are students, most from rural and country Australia. Everyone cooks, cleans and makes their own decisions, while still being in a supportive, Christian atmosphere. A house committee, the church community and Hope Uniting minister pastorally support residents.

What is required of you?

The idea behind Corio is that residents are offered subsidized rent (in comparison to equivalent accommodation in the area), and are encouraged to participate in the Hope Uniting Church community. There are a variety of ways to participate; music, worship, small groups, student groups on campus, local environmental groups – the list goes on! The focus is upon developing your gifts and participating in community.

Where is it?

Corio House is on Anzac Parade, Maroubra Junction in Sydney's Eastern Suburbs. It is 2 minutes to shops and buses, 10 minutes to UNSW and 35 minutes to USyd and UTS, and 10 minute walk to the beach.

How much?

Rent is \$140.00 per week including wireless broadband internet and electricity. Bond of 4 weeks rent is payable upon moving in.
